



## Lorraine Glassworks







The Alsace-Lorraine region has been well-known for its glass production since the Gallo-Roman Era (1st century BCE to 5th century CE). In the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> centuries, these glassmakers began manufacturing stronger (and sparklier) crystal.

Well-known glassmakers in the region include Baccarat, Lalique, and Saint-Louis.





## Haut Koeningsbourg Castle




